During 2023, the Blessing Pantry collected/purchased over 92,672 pounds of food, cleaning and hygiene products. A total of 1,680 bags of food, cleaning and hygiene products were distributed during 34 Giveaway days in a 11 month period in 2023.

CRAFTER RULES

- **What is Prohibited:** Serving of alcoholic beverages; clothing, banners, and signs that endorse offensive language; smoking inside buildings.
- Set-up time: 8:15am to 9:45 am. Cars & trucks will be directed to an assigned parking area. Crafters must supply their own tables, chairs and tents.
- Crafters may only sell those goods they have listed on their application. Those displaying and/or selling products that have not been approved by the promoters will be instructed to remove them. All sales must be conducted in or next to your booth.
- Crafters are asked not to break down their booth until after 2:00pm and place all trash in Trinity Church garbage & recycling dumpsters before leaving. All cardboard must be flattened before being deposited into the recycling dumpster.
