

The Blessing Pantry Fall Fair Crafter Application

The Blessing Pantry at Trinity Episcopal Church (501c3) is sponsoring *The Blessing Pantry Fall Fair* on October 28, 2023. The Blessing Pantry is a free-standing shed that is open 24 hours a day/7 days a week. We invite our neighbors to "take what you need, leave what you can, and go with God's blessing." Last year we served an estimated 13,000 people, which included daily usage of the shed, monthly giveaways of food, cleaning, and hygiene products, and Holiday Dinner boxes distributed during Thanksgiving and Christmas. This year we have already collected and distributed over 37,000 pounds of food, personal hygiene and cleaning products to an estimated 6,300+ neighbors. All proceeds from *The Blessing Pantry Fall Fair* will go to The Blessing Pantry and its mission to assist our neighbors.

CRAFTER RULES

- What is Prohibited: Serving of alcoholic beverages; clothing, banners, and signs that endorse offensive language; smoking inside buildings.
- Set-up time: 8:15am to 9:45 am. Cars & trucks will be directed to an assigned parking area. Crafters must supply their own tables, chairs and tents.
- Crafters may only sell those goods they have listed on their application. Those displaying and/or selling products that have not been approved by the promoters will be instructed to remove them. All sales must be conducted in or next to your booth.
- Crafters are asked not to break down their booth until after 3:00pm and place all trash in Trinity Church garbage & recycling dumpsters before leaving. All cardboard must be flattened before being deposited into the recycling dumpster.
